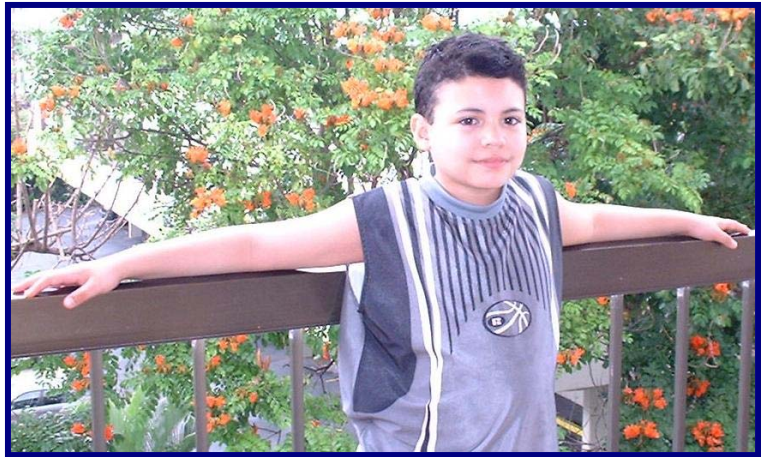


Meet Tray Meet Tray
