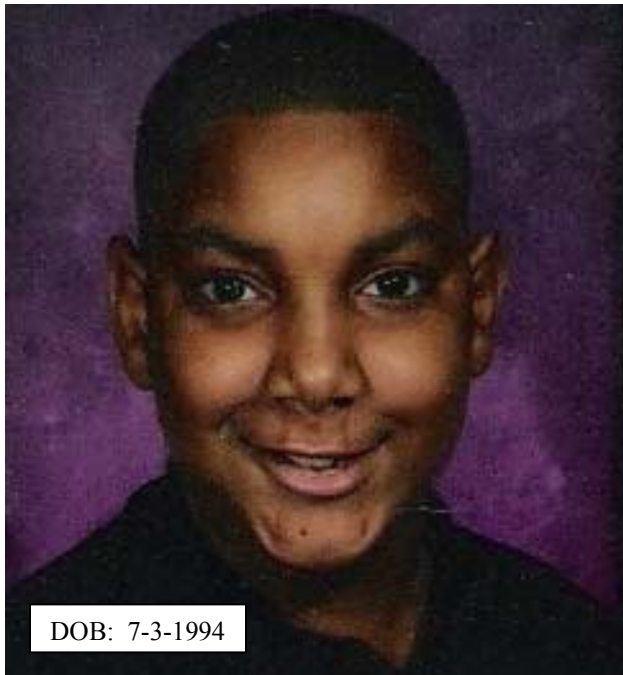




Meet Hakeem
