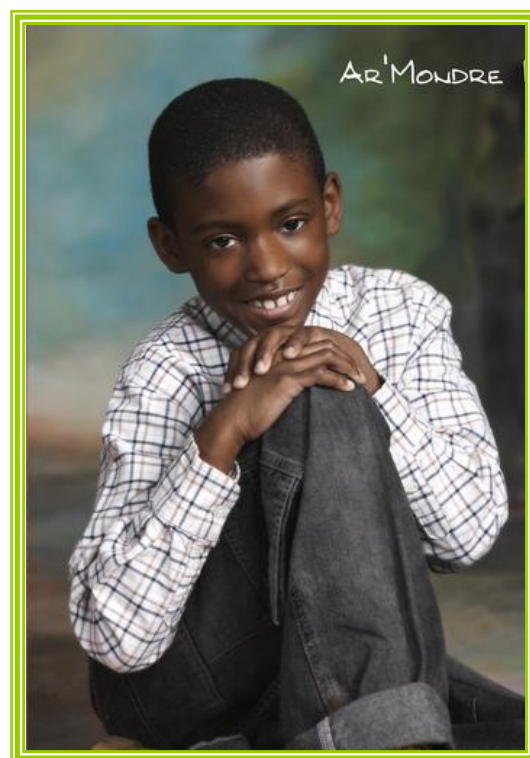


# Meet Ar'Mondre
