Our Foster Families

Foster parents provide a safe and stable home for children while their parents work with a social worker or case manager to make a permanent plan for the child's future. Foster parents at LFCS must be 21 years old. They must be responsible, mature adults who display sound judgment, the capacity to provide good care for children and the motivation to foster.



Your Responsibilities

- Maintain regular visits with your social worker or case manager.
- Work with your social worker or case manager to create a goal and plan for achieving that goal.
- Maintain contact with your child(ren),

Life can be stressful. If your child(ren) is between the ages of 0 and 5, we can help you. We can provide temporary care for them while you work with a social worker or case manager to get your life back on track. We will work with you to create a plan in order to achieve your goals, which may include getting stable housing, finding a job, or securing child care. Our care is short term, and we want your children back with you as soon as possible.
