OPENNESS

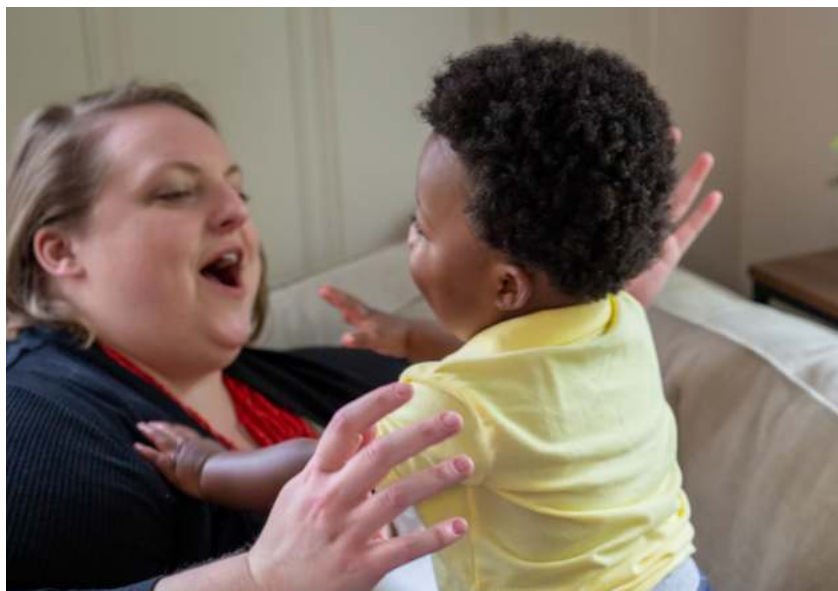
We plan to share pictures and letters with you over the years, and we are open to meeting before the birth. We hope to have a relationship that grows over time to include direct contact and in-person meetings.
