# *Our Adoption Journey*

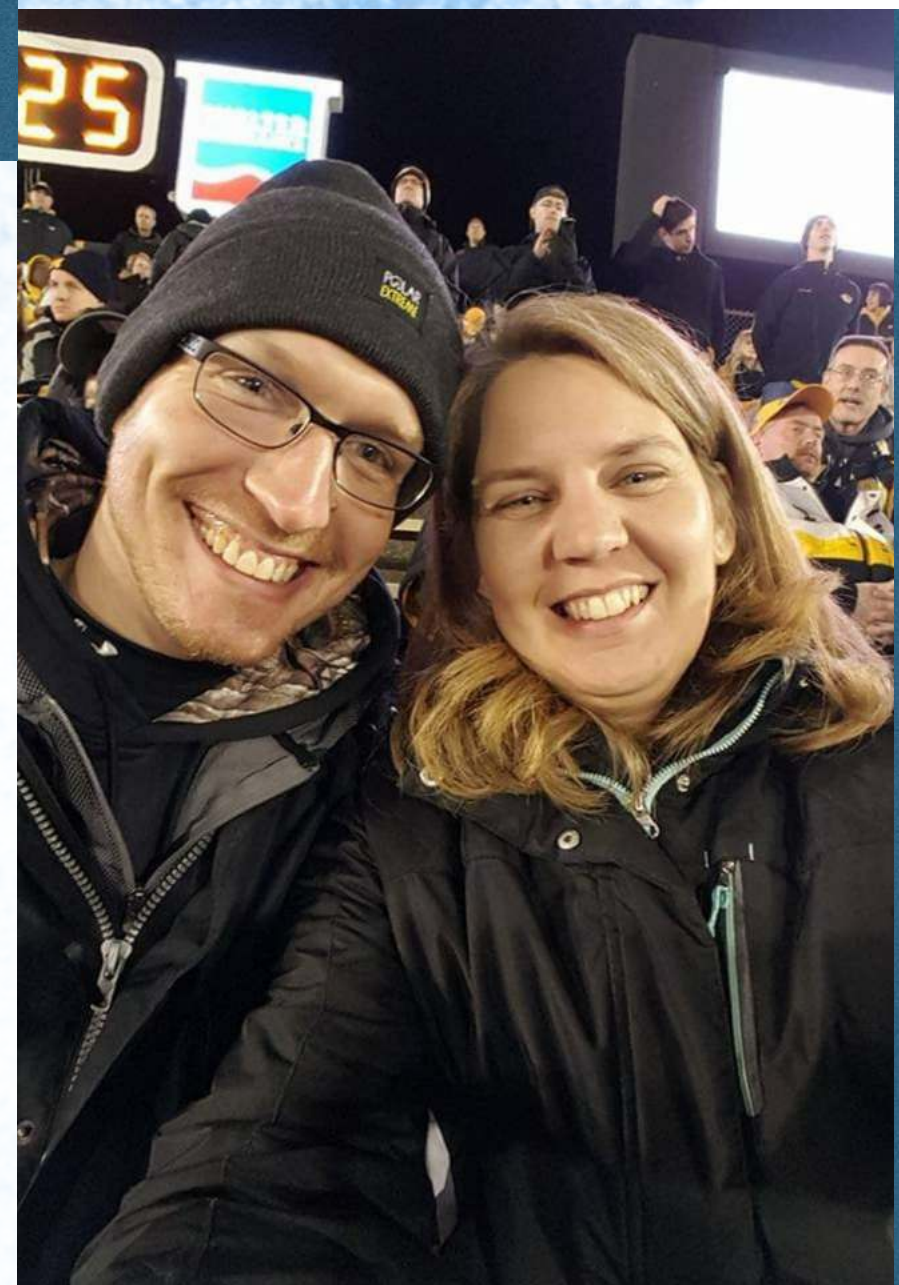

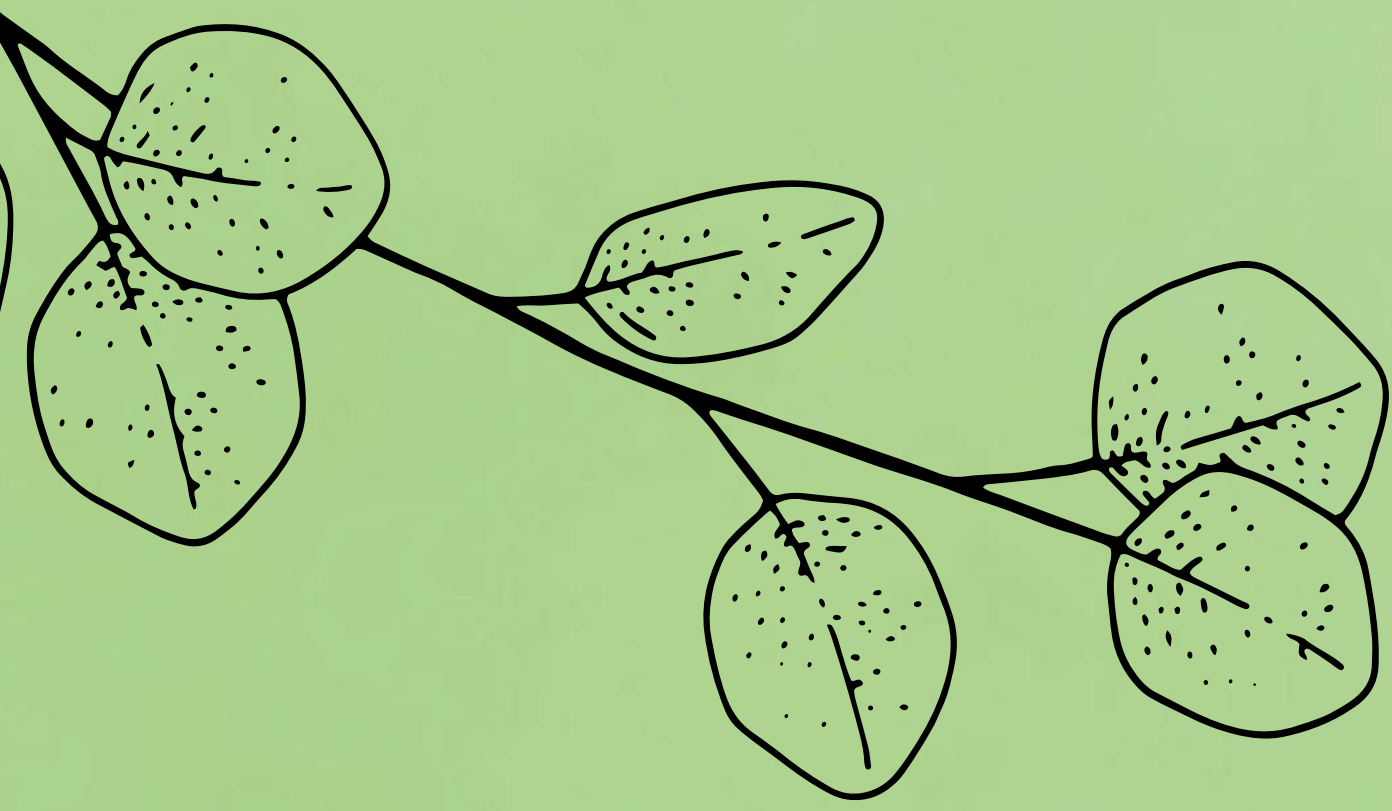
