 $\sqrt{\text{Research adoption agencies.}}$ Different agencies offer different types of adoption and adoption support. Gather information and meet with various agencies to find the right fit for your family.

 $\sqrt{\text{Understand adoption.}}$ Understanding the core issues in adoption is paramount. As an example, loss and grief are experienced by all members of the adoption triad (birth parents, adoptive parents, and the adoptee). Begin reading to learn more and fully understand what adoption means.

 $\sqrt{$ **Build your support network.** Every adoption phase has challenges, and families will need support and understanding from their loved ones. Talk with your loved ones about what to expect and how they can help.

 $\sqrt{\text{Connect with other adoptive families.}}$ Adoptive parents and adoptees benefit from connecting with others who have also experienced and understand the unique experience of adoption.

 $\sqrt{\text{Consider financial options.}}$ Explore grants, loans, and financial assistance programs to help overcome potential obstacles.

 $\sqrt{\text{Seek support}}$. LFCS offers a full-service approach for potential adoptive families. Consider expert guidance from our caseworkers.
