Dear Birth Parent,

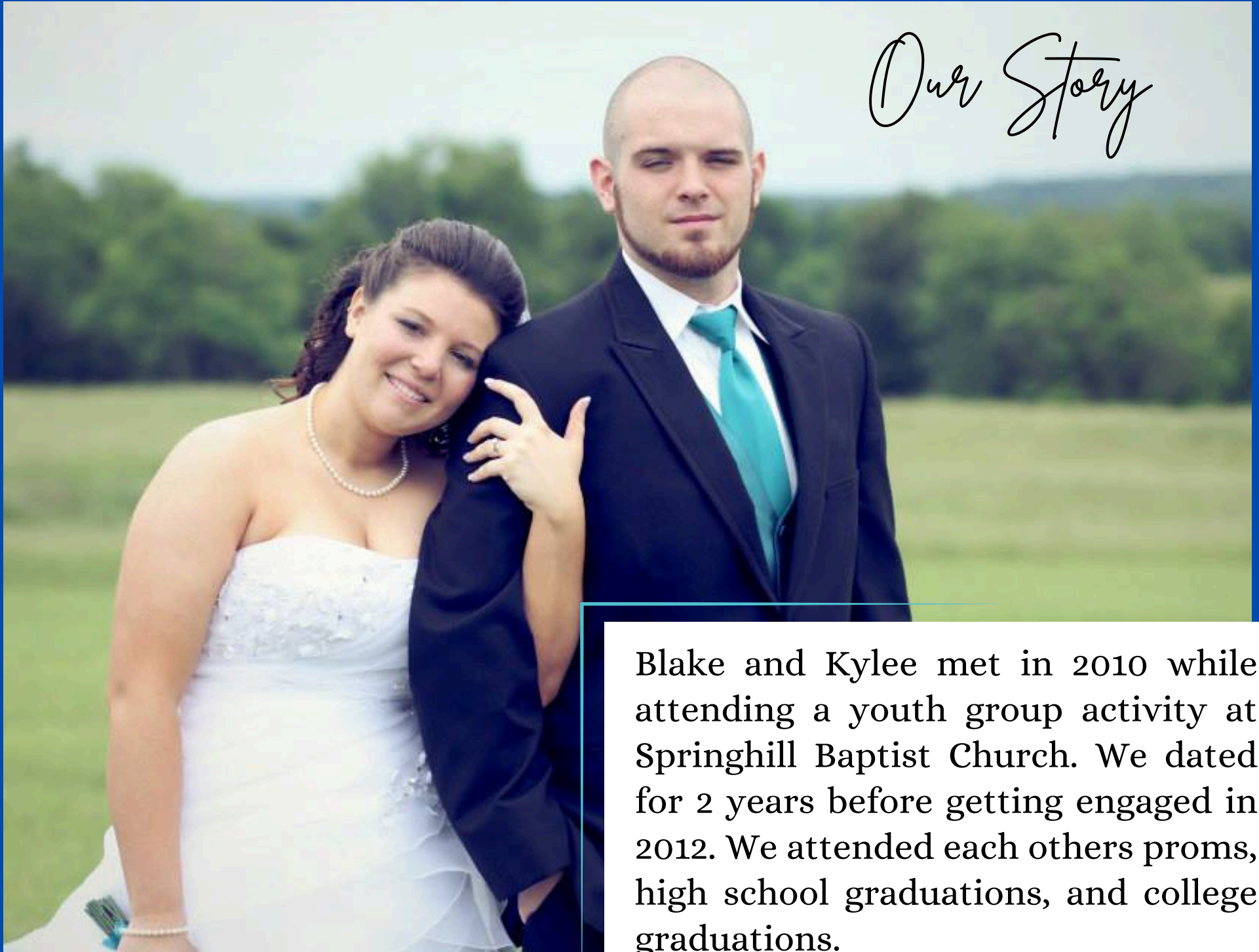
We want to thank you for considering adoption for your baby. We know this is a scary time full of big decisions. Your strength and courage to place your baby for adoption is admiral.

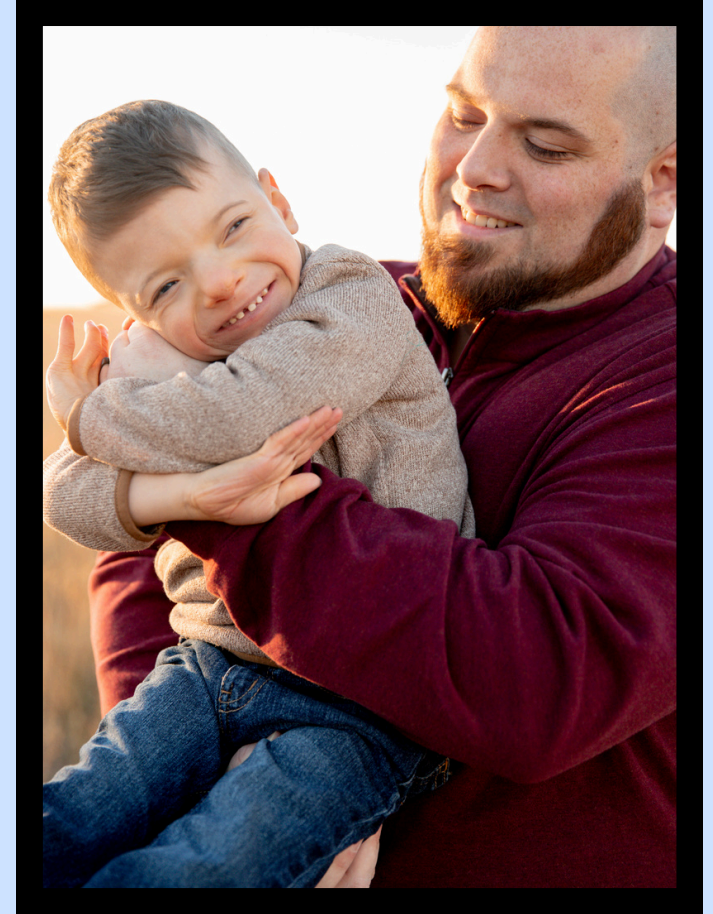
We are praying for you and the decisions you are about to make. We are dreaming about our future with this new baby and thank you for making this dream a reality for our family.

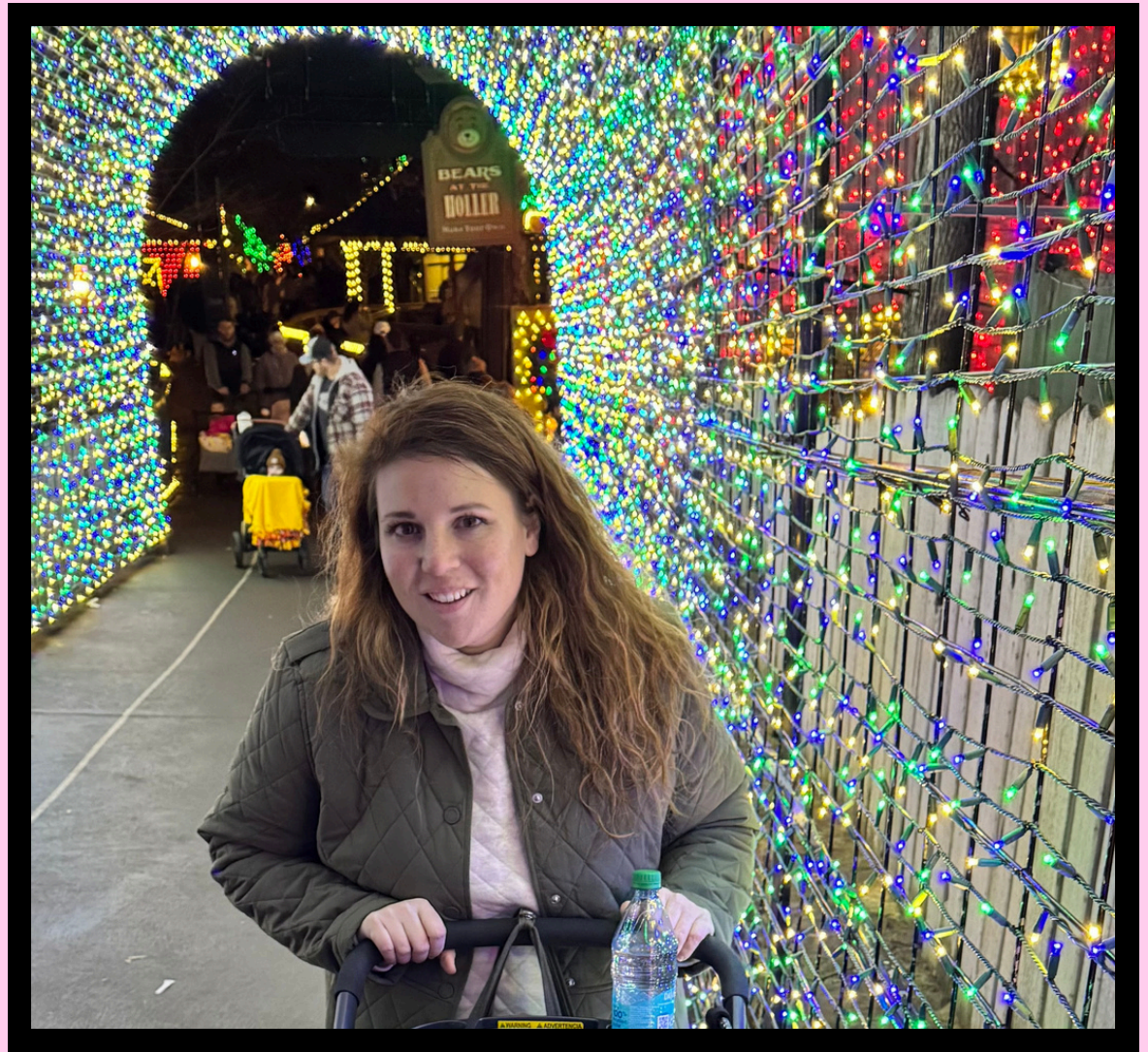


All About Blake

All About Nolan

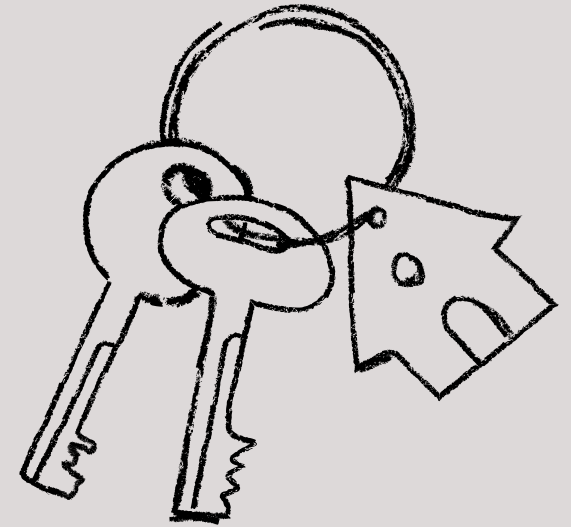
